

Dear Mr Bartnicki,

Please find below additional Polish remarks to the draft EMEP report on Atmospheric Supply of Nitrogen, Lead, Cadmium, Mercury and Lindane to the Baltic Sea in 2002. We would be grateful for incorporating them to the final version.

Chapter 3 "The measurements":

1. Page 18, Table 2.2: Information on the Polish laboratory mentioned as the last one in the table should be deleted. That laboratory does not participate in analysis of samples collected at the Łeba station PL04 (the only Polish EMEP station which results of measurements are submitted to the HELCOM). Samples collected at the Łeba station are analyzed by laboratory mentioned as 5th in the table. As a result, information on Polish laboratory in the last paragraph (the same page) should be deleted as well.
2. According to the table 3.1., figure 3.2. should also reflect the Łeba station.

Chapter 4 „Nitrogen”:

Figures on pages 35, 36, 38 and 39 are hardly readable.

Chapter 6 „Cadmium”:

Page 65, Table 6.6: According to the measurement results obtained at the Łeba station annual mean for cadmium concentrations in precipitation for 2002 is 0.051 µg/m³ (not 0.115 µg/m³). Please check with country report.

Appendix A "Tables with measurements available at HELCOM stations"

Page 98: Table regarding (NO₃+HNO₃) and (NH₃+NH₄) lacks information on the Łeba station.
